Create 5 examples of missing numbers to 100 activities for Primary 2 children.

- 1. Spot the Missing Numbers: Have the students identify which numbers are missing from a given sequence, up to 100.
- 2. Counting by Fives: Have the students count by fives up to 100 and cross off the numbers they say as they count.
- 3. Matching Pairs: Provide students with sets of number cards and ask them to match the numeral labels with the correct missing number.
- 4. Graph It: Provide a blank 100's chart for the students to complete by filling in the blank numbers in the rows and columns.
- 5. Numerical Order: Provide the students with a sequence of mixed up numbers, up to 100, and ask them to identify and put them in numerical order.
