

Create 5 examples of missing numbers to 100 activities for Primary 2 children.

1. **Spot the Missing Numbers:** Have the students identify which numbers are missing from a given sequence, up to 100.
2. **Counting by Fives:** Have the students count by fives up to 100 and cross off the numbers they say as they count.
3. **Matching Pairs:** Provide students with sets of number cards and ask them to match the numeral labels with the correct missing number.
4. **Graph It:** Provide a blank 100's chart for the students to complete by filling in the blank numbers in the rows and columns.
5. **Numerical Order:** Provide the students with a sequence of mixed up numbers, up to 100, and ask them to identify and put them in numerical order.
