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create a lesson based on the following learning intention and success criteria.

Learning Intention: to understand the dangers and benefits of water.

Success Criteria: to create a poster, to make a list, to make an announcement to the class.

Lesson:

1. Introduction (5 minutes):

- Introduce the lesson topic - the dangers and benefits of water - and discuss the importance of water in our daily lives.
- Explain that in this lesson, the students will be creating a poster, making a list, and making an announcement to the class related to the dangers and benefits of water.

2. Group Work (15 minutes):

- Divide the students into small groups of 4-5 students each.
- Assign each group with one of the following tasks:
 - A. Create a poster that illustrates the dangers and benefits of water
 - B. Make a list of the dangers and benefits of water
 - C. Make an announcement to the class about the importance of water
- Give each group an appropriate amount of time and resources to complete their task.

3. Presentations (15 minutes):

- Have each group present their posters, lists, and announcements to the class.
- Give feedback and discussion opportunities related to the presentations.

4. Reflection (5 minutes):

- Go over the learning intention and success criteria listed in the beginning of the lesson.
- Have a discussion on the importance of learning about the dangers and benefits of water.
- Provide an opportunity for the students to reflect on their understanding of the

lesson.
